What to Bring

Ensure children come to OSHC with:

- Packed recess, lunch and drink bottle.
- Weather appropriate clothing including sun safe hats or wet weather gear.
- Enclosed shoes.
- Spare change of clothes for younger children.

Bookings

All bookings and cancellations are made by parents/caregivers using our online booking system; Fully Booked.

Please ensure you read the description for each of the scheduled days and come prepared for the anticipated activities, including departure times for excursions.

If a session is at full capacity, Fully Booked gives you the ability to add your child/ren to a waitlist. If you choose to do so, you will be notified by email if a space becomes available.

OSHC & Covid-19

Cobbler Creek OSHC follows the latest SA Health and Department for Education health advice.

Please do not send children to OSHC who are displaying Covid 19 symptoms such as; fever, temperature, cough, sore throat.

Children displaying these symptoms will be sent home.

Cancellations

Bookings are final. Cancelling will incur full fee. Exceptions only for presenting a doctors certificate.

In order to keep your child care subsidy active, children must attend at least one session within a twelve week period. If this does not occur, the full fee will be charged by Centrelink, keeping in mind absences do not count as physical attendance.

Medical & Dietary Needs

The National Quality Framework outlines strict guidelines in regards to how medication, medical action plans and risk minimization forms are maintained within the OSHC service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of those that attend, and how they must be accessible to staff at all times.

Please ensure that these documents and any required medication are provided to OSHC in a timely matter. Children with out of date documentation or medication will not be able to attend.
