Monday

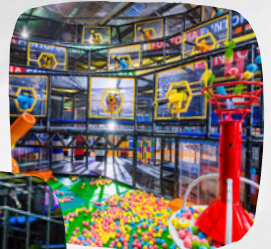


FUNTOPTIA

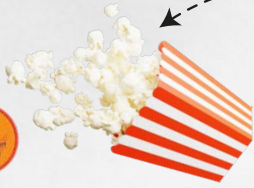
