
We focused on fostering essential life skills including teamwork, problem-solving, and creativity. Your child had the opportunity to explore their interests and talents through a variety of activities.

The service follows a 7 day cancellation policy for BSC and ASC, which includes swapping of sessions. One weeks notice is required to adjust and meet the ratio/ staffing needs. Please keep this in mind when making and cancelling bookings for your children.
