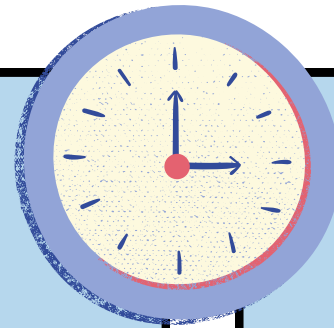

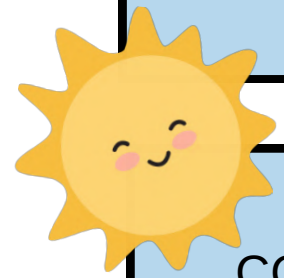
### Operating Hours

Cobbler Creek OSHC operates from 7am - 6pm from Monday to Friday, Excluding Public Holidays.



### Sun Safety

CCOSHC follows the Cancer Council SunSmart Policy which requires all staff and children to wear a sun safe hat that protects their face, ears and neck when the UV rating is 3 or higher. When outdoors, staff and children are to wear sun safe clothing that covers their head, shoulders, back and stomach. (Refer to CCOSHC Sun Safety Policy)

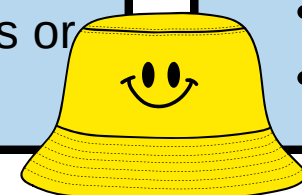


**Children wearing clothes without full coverage and/or without a hat will not be permitted to play outside or come on our excursions.**

Sunscreen is provided and is applied throughout the day. If your child requires sensitive/anything other than what we provide, it is to be placed in their bag with their name on it.

### What to wear

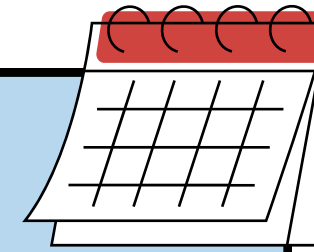
- Tops that cover shoulders (crop tops, singlets or sleeveless dresses are **NOT** permitted).

### Cancellations

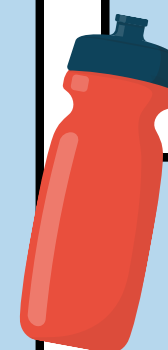
All Vacation Care bookings are final and cancellations will incur full charge with the exception of a sick certificate. Please make all cancellations via the FullyBooked website.

- We recommend packing a spare set of clothes, especially for younger children.

Please make bookings in advance as days fill up fast. If the day you are booking is full, you can choose to add your child/ren to the waitlist. You will be notified by email if your booking request has been accepted and your child is moved off the waitlist. Make sure that you check your emails (junk/spam folder) as this will be your official confirmation of the booking.



**Departure & Arrival times:** Departure & Arrival times for excursions are approximate and we request that you bring your children to OSHC half an hour before the bus is scheduled to leave in order to get prepared for our excursions.

**Buses:** All buses provided during the Vacation Care period are private chartered through LinkSA.

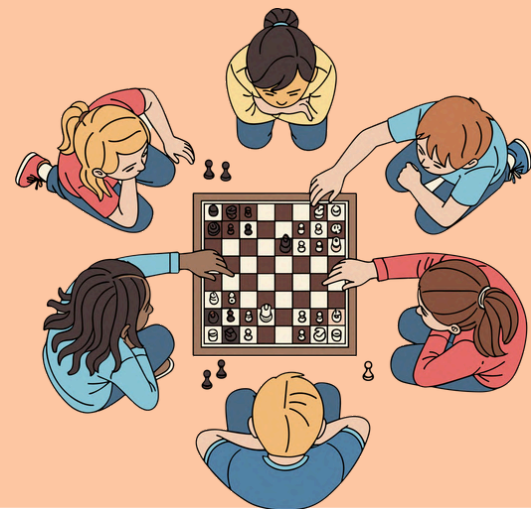
# Chess Mates

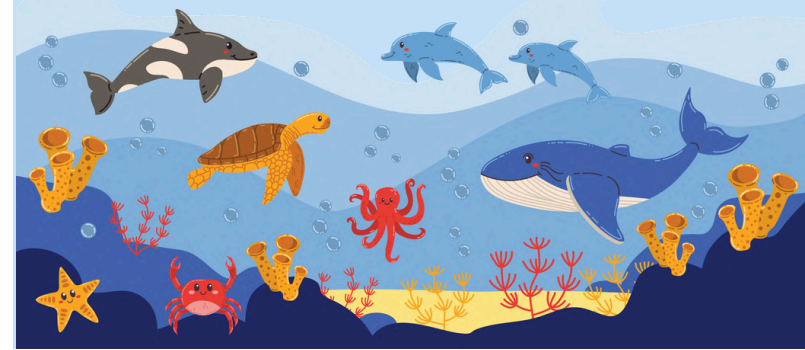
